Brief Description of Trainers :

1. Dr. Mee-Lee is a board-certified psychiatrist, and is certified by the American Board of Addiction Medicine (ABAM). Based in Davis, California, he trains and consults both nationally and internationally. Dr. Mee-Lee is Chief Editor of The ASAM Criteria and is Senior Vice President of The Change Companies. He is also a Senior Fellow, Justice Programs Office (JPO) of the School of Public Affairs (SPA) at American University, Washington, DC. Dr. Mee-Lee has over thirty years experience in person centered treatment and program development for people with co-occurring mental health and substance use conditions.

2. Dr Chung is the Associate Consultant Psychiatrist in the Department of Psychiatry of Queen Mary Hospital. He is also an Honorary Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry of the University of Hong Kong. He has rich experience working with drug abuse problem and he is specialized in working with youth with drug abuse problem.

3. Ms. Chan has over 20 years working experience with addictions and co-occurring disorders. She is now the supervisor of the TWGHs Integrated Centre on Addiction Prevention and Treatment (ICAPT). Ms. Chan has obtained the Master Addiction Counsellor (MAC) credential and is an approved Education Provider of NAADAC. Ms. Chan has published a number of papers and book chapters on addiction, and is one of the authors for the Chinese G-Map, clinical assessment for gambling disorder.

4. Ms. Chung has over 20 years working experience with youths' emotional and behavioral problems including drug abuse and addictions. Ms. Chung is the supervisor of Counseling Centre for Psychotropic Substance Abusers (CROSS) and the Alcoholic Treatment Service.
